

A working tool for all stakeholders from the private and public sector concerned with socioeconomic development of our region, at both national, regional and local level Demographic trends

Demographic trends are affected by social and economic developments.

Migration flows, in particular, are related to regional differences in labour market conditions, people moving from areas of low job growth to ones with more employment opportunities

will be determined by a range of economic and social factors, most especially by the availability of jobs, but also by education developments, the availability of child-care support

a tendency to 'suburbanisation', the movement out of city centres to the suburbs and neighbouring

building up the region's human capital—through education and workforce development reforms that gradually develop common standards in key sectors across the region—will offer better economic opportunities for the region's citizens, creating an engine for growth in each country and strengthening the region's competitiveness
