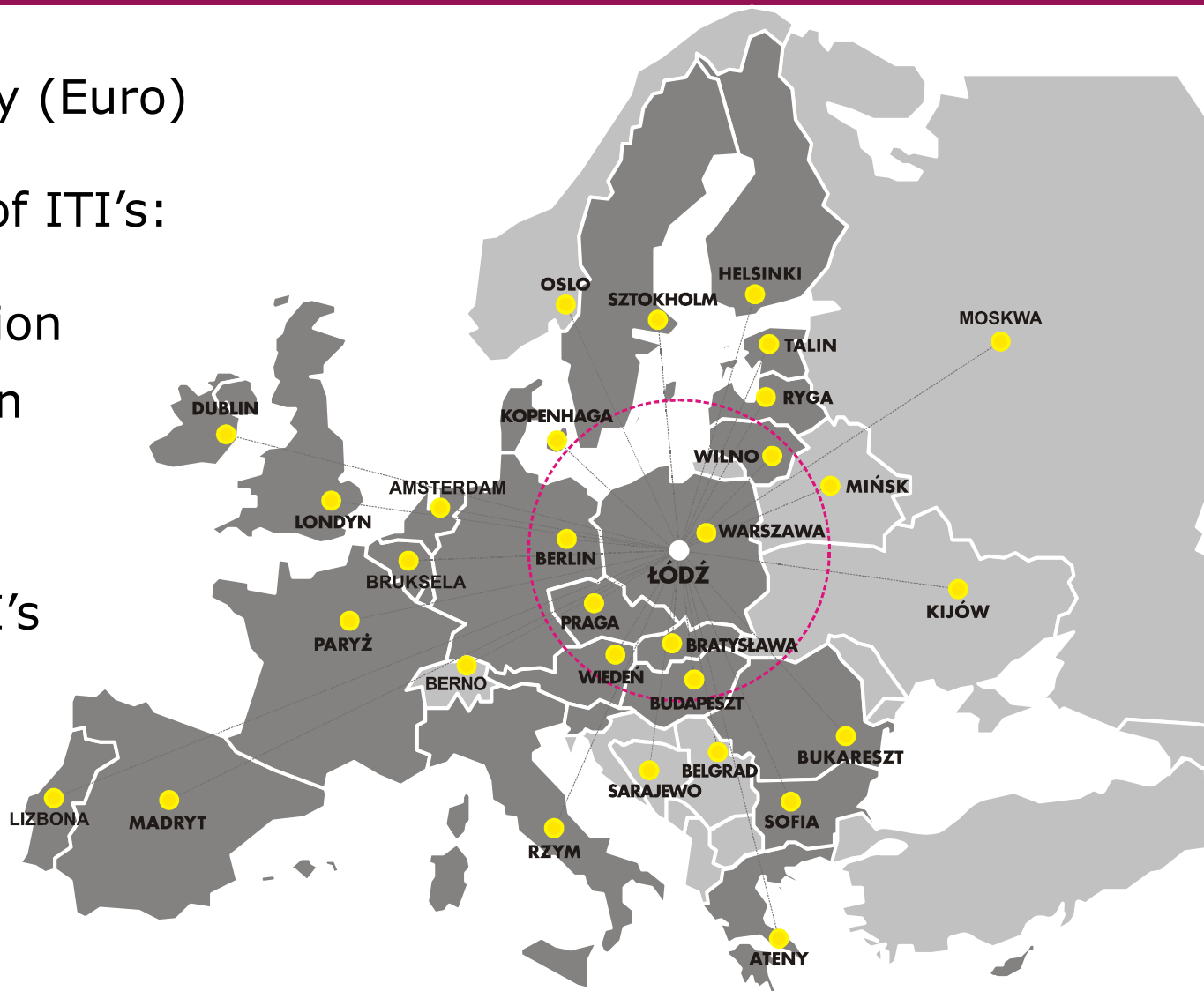

## **Łódź Metropolitan Area (ŁMA)**

- number of inhabitants: 1,1 mln
- area: 2 499 km<sup>2</sup>
- generates approx. 50% of voivodeship's GDP

## **Łódź Metropolitan Area Association**

- consists of 31 administrative territorial units
- will serve as an Intermediate Body for the implementation of ITI's in the region

- *The development of modern human and social capital and a strong information society;*
- *Strengthening of metropolitan functions and cohesion of the metropolitan area*
