

Łódź Metropolitan Area (ŁMA)

- number of inhabitants: 1,1 mln
- area: 2 499 km2
- generates approx. 50% of voivodeship's GDP

Łódź Metropolitan Area Association

- consists of 31 administrative territorial units
- will serve as an Intermediate Body for the implementation of ITI's in the region



Development Strategy for ŁMA 2020+

- adapted in July 2014
- > serves as:
 - general strategy for the MA
 - operational stategy for ITI's





Main strategic objectives:

- Regeneration of degraded areas to build friendly and safe spaces fostering social inclusion and the increase of economic activity;
- Development of an integrated and sustainable metropolitan transport system;
- The development of low-carbon and resource-efficient economy and protection of natural environment;
- The development of modern human and social capital and a strong information society;
- Strengthening of metropolitan functions and cohesion of the metropolitan area
